## 2. DETAILED SCOPE OF THE STAFF MEDICAL COVER FOR KENYATTA NATIONAL HOSPITAL

The scope of Insurance Medical cover has been amended to include maternity cover limits as indicated below

The insurance shall cover a Member or his spouse for childbirth, provided the member or spouse is admitted in an insurance contracted hospital. The maternity benefit package covers the following services where Medically Necessary:

- a. Reception and registration, triaging, consultation charges, laboratory investigations, ward care and accommodation.
- b. Labor, Delivery, aftercare for the mother together with the newborn including Oral poliovirus vaccines (OPV) zero and Bacille Calmette-Guérin (BCG) vaccines for the newborn and post discharge medication;
- c. Midwifery and surgical services pertaining to child birth by ways of normal delivery, assisted delivery and emergency caesarean section;
- d. General nursing care;
- e. Lactation consultations;
- f. Meals and special diets;
- g. Operating, recovery, maternity and other treatment rooms;
- h. Prescribed drugs and medicines;
- i. Administration of blood and blood products;
- j. Blood products, derivatives and components, artificial blood products and biological serum. Blood products include any product created from a component of blood such as, but not limited to, plasma, packed red blood cells, platelets, albumin, factor VIII, immunoglobulin and prolactin;
- k. Medical supplies and equipment, including oxygen;
- l. Anesthetics, including professional anesthetist services;
- m. Take-home items;
- n. Medical supplies, appliances, medical equipment, and any covered items billed by a hospital for use at home; and



- o. Management of intra-admission postpartum infections and hemorrhage, birth traumas and conditions related to child birth will be covered within the package
- p. Emergency Caesarean Section will be covered within the inpatient limit.
- q. Maternity cover for normal deliveries of up to KShs. 150,000 is within the inpatient limit for all Job Groups.

All other terms and conditions remain the same as tender publication. The Tender Closing date remains as earlier communicated i.e **6<sup>th</sup> December, 2023** at 10:00am East African Time.
