NB: An additional fee of <b>Kshs.23, 400</b> is payable directly to the Nursing Council of Kenya for indexing, training materials and licensure examination.			
Foreign students are required to pay 300 USD to NCK and obtain a temporary license <b>before</b> commencement of a course. They should also submit official translations of their certificates & transcripts if in any other language other than English. Equation of certificate grades by Kenya National Examination Council (KNEC) is also required.			
Each student will be required to have an NHIF card or other Health Insurance cover for the period.

#### Qualifications:

- Diploma in KRN/M, KRCHN or Bachelors degree in Nursing (BScN).
- Two (2) years post registration as a Registered Nurse.
- Must have attained a “C” Minus or Div III in O level.
- Must be registered by the Nursing Council of Kenya and has a valid practicing license.
- Proficiency in English is mandatory for foreign students.

KNH staff Must have served for a period of three (3) years and should apply through their departmental heads.
