Requirements:

- Diploma in KRN/M, KRCHN or Bachelor's degree in Nursing (BScN).
- Two (2) years post registration as a Registered Nurse.
- Must have attained a "C" plain KCSE ("C-" minus for the upgraded nurses) or Div. III in O level
- Must be registered by the Nursing Council of Kenya or their country Board and have a valid practicing license.
- Proficiency in English is mandatory for foreign students.

Foreign students are required to submit official translations of their certificates & transcripts if in any other language other than English. Equation of certificate grades by Kenya National Qualifications Authority (KNAQ) is also required before commencement of training.

Each student will be required to have a Health Insurance cover for the period of training. Application fee of **Kshs.1,500** /- is payable to Kenyatta National Hospital through **e-citizen** KNH staff Must have served for a period of three (3) years and should apply through their departmental heads.

All Application letters accompanied by copies of academic and professional certificates should be addressed to **the Chief Executive Officer, Kenyatta National Hospital**, Att' HOD/Principal- KNH School of Nursing and should be delivered to KNH School of Nursing Admin office.
