- ✚ KRN/M, KRCHN/BScN
- ✚ Two years working experience (3 years for KNH staff)
- ✚ KCSE 'C' Plain KCSE ('C-'minus for upgraded nurses) or Div III 'O' Level
- ✚ Professional certificates
- ✚ NCK Registration Certificate
- ✚ Valid NCK Practice License
- ✚ National ID/Passport

NB: Foreign students must have equivalent of all requirements and their certificates must be equated by Kenya National Qualifications Authority (KNQA).

## Certificate Courses for Health Care Workers *(Applications for courses ongoing)*

- ✚ Stoma, Wound and Continence Care (SWCC) course for healthcare workers
- ✚ Theatre & Sterile Services Assistant (TSSA) course

### Admission Requirements:

1. Stoma, Wound and Continence Care (SWCC) Course for Healthcare Workers
  - The course is open to qualified healthcare workers with a valid license from the relevant regulatory body.
2. Theatre & Sterile Services Assistant Course (TSSA)
  - Applicants for this course must be 'O' level with a minimum grade of "D" plain or its equivalent.

### Application Guidelines

- All applicants should attach legible copies of academic, professional certificates, valid practice license (where applicable) and National identity card
- Applicants should attach an e-citizen application fee payment receipt
- Applicants should provide their email address and mobile phone numbers for communication.

Application fee for all courses is **Kshs.1, 500/-** is payable to Kenyatta National Hospital **via e-Citizen**.

Each student will be required to have a Health Insurance cover for the period of training

Those who meet criteria will be Selected and contacted through their mobile phones. Only selected applicants will be contacted.

KNH staff Must have served for a period of three (3) years and should apply through their departmental heads.

All Application letters accompanied by copies of academic and professional certificates should be addressed to the Chief Executive Officer, Kenyatta National Hospital, Att' HOD/Principal-KNH School of Nursing and should be delivered to KNH School of Nursing Admin office.
